PARK MANAGER:

* LEAF RAKING IS FAST APPROACHING. PLEASE FOLLOW A FEW SIMPLE GUIDELINES:

- 1-DO NOT RAKE YOUR LEAVES INTO THE ROADWAY
- 2- DO NOT PUT YOUR LEAVES ON COMMON GROUND
- 3- ALL LEAVES NEED TO BE RAKED TO THE SIDE OF THE ROAD IN PILES
- 4- STICKS AND ROCKS NEED TO BE SEPERATED FROM LEAVES.

* AS EACH LOT OWNER HAS CLOSED UP FOR THE WINTER AND A FINAL PUMPOUT HAS BEEN DONE, AN ORANGE TAG WILL BE PLACED ON YOUR SEPTIC OUTLET. THIS IS SOLEY FOR MY RECORDS TO MAKE SURE EVERYONE HAS BEEN PUMPED OUT TO HELP ELIMINATE ANY FREEZE UPS IN YOUR TANK.

* IF POSSIBLE, PLEASE NOTIFY THE PARK MANAGER OR PARK PERSONNEL WHEN CLOSING UP, SO PROPER MEASURES CAN BE TAKEN. (FINAL PUMPOUT AND TIGHTEN SECURITY, ETC.)

* LOT OWNER'S WHO HAVE PAID FOR SNOW PLOWING HAVE TWO TEMPORARY MARKERS PLACED AT THE AREA YOU WISH TO BE PLOWED.

* **AS A REMINDER** WE STILL HAVE PEOPLE IN THE PARK ALL SEASON LONG. SO, OBEY THE SPEED LIMIT. SPEEDING IS A MAJOR ISSUE AND IF CONTINUES ALTERNATE MEASURES MAY NEED TO BE ENFORCED. **"ONLY YOU CAN PREVENT SPEED BUMPS"**.

* AS OF OCTOBER 18TH THE TRASH CONTAINERS WILL BE AT THE POLE BARN FOR THE WINTER.

* BUILDING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED ON CERTAIN ALTERATIONS OR RENOVATIONS. PLEASE LOOK AT YOUR RULES AND REGULATIONS BOOKLET TO SEE IF YOU NEED TO OBTAIN A PERMIT. IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS PLEASE CONTACT PARK MANAGER. 989-293-3153.

UPDATES FROM THE OFFICE MANAGER

1- MAINTENANCE DUES

Maintenance invoices are going to be mailed out the 3rd week of November. The amount is \$410.00 for the 2011 camping season. Maintenance Fees are due January 1, 2011 (not on Memorial Weekend). Please submit payment promptly to avoid finance charges. These payments are the source of income, allowing the Park the ability to maintain throughout the year.

2- FINAL ELECTRIC FOR 2010

Electric invoices are due upon receipt. The final reading will take place after the water is shut off and the end of the year invoice will be issued. If payment is not received for the balance encountered for the 2010 season, services will not be available in 2011. A reconnection fee of \$50.00 will be added before services are reconnected.

3- SPRING LOT RAKING

Anyone needing someone to rake his or her lot in the spring can contact me at the office anytime. I have a list of people available to rake yards. I will give you the name and contact number to set up an arrangement. Payment will be made to the party doing the raking, not to Cedar Shores Campground. Remember Cedar Shores will issue a service charge for non-raked lots after May 31st. The Park IS NOT RESPONSIBLE for the raking or cleaning up lots (front, back and sides inclusive).

4- NEW RULES AND REGULATION BOOKLET

Anyone that has not received a copy of the NEW Rules and Regulations booklet, please see me in the office. Management is enforcing these rules and regulations, so, you do need to know them.

Winter office hours are Saturday 10am - noon.

The tentative date for the 2011 Bonfire will be posted on the website early January.



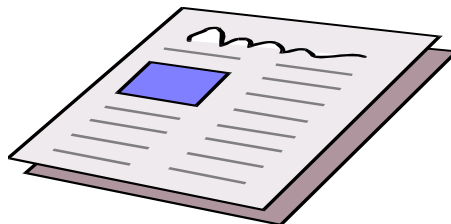
Recreation Committee News....
