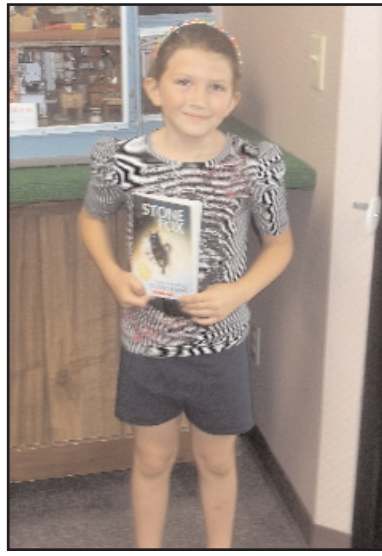


# Harrison Library Book Winners
