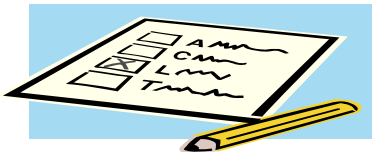

We have had a VERY good response to the “911 information sheets.’ If you haven’t filled one out, please do so. Central dispatch uses this information to help save time and possibly a life. The more information you include on the fact sheet, the fewer questions will need to be asked if responding to the call. This information is entered into the central dispatch computer and used nowhere else. We do not keep a copy of it in the office. The form you give me is turned over directly to the Sheriff’s department. The only copy is the one you make for yourself, which is advisable. Please talk to your neighbors, friends and family that have health conditions and/or on prescription medication. Ask if they have filled the form out for the emergency staff and either mailed it in or turned it into the office. Forms are available at the office, at the laundry facility or in the Rec. Hall.

Placing an ad on the website has benefited owners that have rentals and that are trying to sell. I receive emails and phone calls asking if other places are for sale or those that are rentals. They comment that they have checked the website and was wondering if there was any more. The service is free, as long as you own the lot. 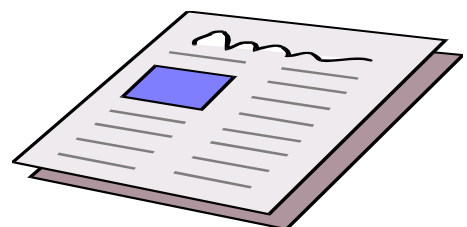
