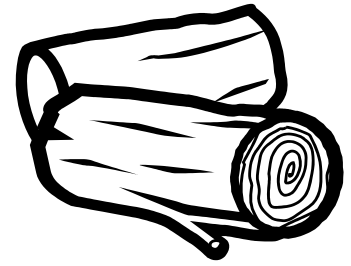

Memorial day weekend went good. No reports of vandalism or problems throughout the park.

In regards to the trailer fire I have been in contact with the lot owner and the trailer was to be removed by Friday, June 21st.

Our annual inspection with the dept of health and DEQ took place on June 6th and the park received a 100% with no violation or discrepancies.

When you are checking out your units please put on your check list to make sure your septic valves are not leaking and your handles are not broken. If they are please replace accordingly.

Also please make sure areas around your septic outlet are clear and free of any obstacles.

The leaf Vac is now parked until the end of the season. If you do any raking please take to the area behind the well house. Do not place it at the road.

We had 24 lots that needed to be cleaned and all lots are done and will be billed accordingly.

The hot water tank for the laundry room broke and was replaced with a hot water on demand system. This unit has already proven to be very cost efficient.

Help is needed to help keep the playground and putt-putt golf and basically throughout the park clean. If you see trash or sticks laying around please help by picking it up and disposing of it.

Any lot owners currently getting their yards cut by the park please make sure yards are free of debris and and pet stakes to assure the mowers can get in and do a good job with no damage.

As the Fourth of July holiday approaches and renters and guest join us at Cedar Shores please update them on the rules and regulations of the park to assure a safe and enjoyable holiday.
