food, cold and hot can be brought to the rec. hall before the golf cart rally begins.

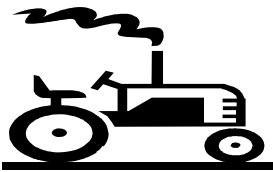
