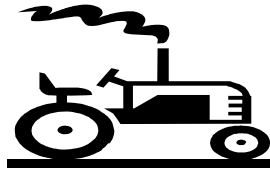

Good morning:

To start Memorial Weekend despite the weather went very well. No reports of vandalism and security checks were done on the bathhouses and no reports of damage.

Leaf pickup is over for the season and will resume in October. The park cleaned 15 lots and all have been invoiced.

As you can see when coming into the park road work has been done. Edges of Cedar Shores Drive were removed from Townline Lake Road to lot 178. This phase of the project took 3 days and has showed a big difference on the amount of rain draining off the roads.

Equipment used was the Park Truck and dump trailer and a skid steer donated by Chad Cross lot 234. The skid steer was operated by Chris Cross lot 256 who in return volunteered his time to help with this project. The park provided fuel for the use of the skid steer. I want to thank these gentlemen for the time and use of the equipment. These areas also have been seeded so please try and stay off them until grass starts showing.

In preparation for the holiday, security will be in full force checking bathhouses and patrolling the park. Please inform your guest when using golf carts or quads on the rules and regulations, remember safety comes first.
